



Resilient Individuals

Respond to the emotional, psychological and physical needs of Jordan's most vulnerable populations, including refugees, persons with disabilities and at-risk adolescents.

Provide intergenerational mental health and psychosocial support

Integrate children with disabilities into formal education and provide Non-Formal Education to school dropouts



Strong Communities and Governance

Build strong, cohesive communities in which people have the ability and opportunity to meaningfully participate in local governance structures and processes.

Utilize Interest-based Negotiation Training to promote conflict resolution and social cohesion outcomes

Build the capacity of government and civil society stakeholders to lead civic engagement processes

Empower community and youth leaders to identify and lead positive solutions for their communities



Environmentally Sustainable and Inclusive Economic Growth

Support economic growth that does not further strain already scarce natural resources and that includes vulnerable populations such as youth and women.


Promote market systems development, private sector engagement, financial inclusion, technology integration, and growth of small and medium enterprises and digital entrepreneurs
